 Technology Information / Permission



Students in grades 6, 7, and 8 began using Google Apps for Education to meet their learning goals. These accounts and tools [provided free to us from Google] allow students to access and use an array of communication, creativity, and collaboration tools within our my.nsdeagles community without advertising. Teachers in other grades from 3-5 are also considering using Google Apps to bring their classrooms and their students into technological learning with an emphasis on digital citizenship expectations and responsibilities. The Common Core State Standards are infused with technology expectations, and our students' future experiences will expect them to be adept at online tools, communication skills, and collaboration skills At Nespelem School, we know the importance of planning and teaching for a future we can only imagine.

What are Google Apps? Applications such as email, collaborative documents [students working together on one document], spreadsheets, slides, and websites provide students with 21st Century tools to utilize and support their learning and their skills for their future. District-issued and controlled student accounts will allow students to access and use an array of Google's communication, creativity, and collaboration tools within their my.nsdeagle.org student community to meet their learning goals with personalized feedback from their teacher.

How it works: As part of a students my.nsdeagles.org account, an email account will be provided to communicate with teachers and each other when necessary. Most student work will be in Docs and Slides. Students will be instructed to share their username and password with their parents so that parents can also monitor student accounts if they choose. If parents have any trouble accessing a student's account, please contact Sheri Edwards [sedwards@nsdeagles.org] or Jenny Hare [jhare@nsdeagles.org]. Students are frequently reminded not to share passwords with anyone other than parents or teacher because students are responsible for issues with their accounts. We discuss this in detail. We have only had one incident of password misuse in four years.

Students will be able to log into their my.nsdeagles.org account from any Internet-connected computer or device. This will allow students to use their account to easily access important files and assignments from home as well as at school.

Security: Use of the my.nsdeagles.org accounts will be governed by the school's Acceptable Use Policy as well as expectations for student behavior [netiquette] which students sign before access. The my.nsdeagles.org and other online apps used by students for learning should be considered an extension of the physical school campus. Students who misuse their account will be subject to disciplinary action by the school administration. We have had minimal incidents because students appreciate the opportunity to work on assignments online. The my.nsdeagles.org accounts are the property of the Nespelem School District and, as with other district technology systems, the use of the accounts should not be considered private.

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Google Apps for Education Permission Form

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Nespelem School District utilizes Google Apps for Education for students, teachers, and staff. This permission form describes the tools and student responsibilities for using these services. As with any educational endeavor, a strong partnership with families is essential to a successful experience.

The following services are available to each student and hosted by Google as part of Nespelem School District's online presence in Google Apps for Education:

- Mail - an individual email account for school use managed by the Nespelem School District
- Calendar - an individual calendar providing the ability to organize schedules, daily activities, and assignments
- Docs - a word processing, spreadsheet, drawing, and presentation toolset that is very similar to Microsoft Office
- Sites - an individual and collaborative website creation tool

Using these tools, students collaboratively create, edit and share files and websites for school related projects and communicate via email with other students and teachers. These services are entirely online and available 24/7 from any Internet-connected computer. Examples of student use include showcasing class projects, building an electronic portfolio of school learning experiences, and working in small groups on presentations to share with others. Why use Google Apps for Education?

- To provide students with access to current technology applications and free tools designed for collaboration with other students and teachers
- To give students the ability to work on their documents both in school and at home - anytime and anywhere from any Internet connected device
- To help students work collaboratively, engage in peer-editing of documents, and publish for a wider audience
- To facilitate "paperless" transfer of work between students and teachers
- To provide adequate (seven gigabytes) long-term storage space for student work
- A potential cost savings in terms of software licensing and document storage

How are the Nespelem School District and Google linked together?

The Google agreement with the Nespelem School District provides access to Google applications and storage. While Google hosts these services off-site, the District maintains the ability to manage users, groups, and settings, much like other locally hosted systems. This means that NSD can grant and remove user access, and control other settings to ensure a safe and secure collaboration environment for students and teachers.

What personal student information and student education records will be stored in Google Apps for Education?

The terms of the Google contract with the Nespelem School District mandate that we must have parental permission for the use of Google Apps for Education. On the Google permission form that parents are asked to sign, it states that "information about my child will be collected and stored electronically." *Google does not request any personal information from students and the District does not provide personal student data* (ex. birthdate, address, phone number, grades, test scores) to Google. That information resides in the NSD student information system and **is not** stored nor available to Google.

The permission form also states that "my student's education records stored in Google Apps for Education may be accessible to someone other than my student and the Nespelem School District". *Examples of student education records in Google are assignments, notes, calendars and projects created by the student.*

Technology use in the Nespelem School District is governed by federal laws including:

Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA)

COPPA applies to commercial companies and limits their ability to collect personal information from children under 13. By default, advertising is turned off for Nespelem School District's presence in Google Apps for Education. No personal student information is collected for commercial purposes. This permission form allows the school to act as an agent for parents in the collection of information within the school context. The school's use of student information is solely for education purposes.

Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)

FERPA protects the privacy of student education records and gives parents the rights to review student records. Under FERPA, schools may disclose directory information (See Board Policy) but parents may request the school not disclose this information. Parents are provided the opportunity annually to opt out of disclosing their student's directory information on the District's Enrollment Form. --FERPA – <http://www.ed.gov/policy/gen/guid/fpco/ferpa>

Guidelines for the responsible use of Google Apps for Education by students:

- 1. **Official Email Address.** All students will be assigned a *username###@my.nsdeagles.org* email account. This account will be considered the student's official NSD email address until such time as the student is no longer enrolled with the Nespelem School District. Student usernames are pseudonyms, not their real names.
- 2. **Prohibited Conduct.** Please refer to the Board Policy N2022 and N2022P, the Acceptable Use Policy and also the Netiquette Expectations
- 3. **Access Restriction.** Access to and use of student email is considered a privilege accorded at the discretion of the Nespelem School District. The District maintains the right to immediately withdraw the access and use of these services including email when there is reason to believe that violations of law or District policies have occurred. In such cases, the alleged violation will be referred to a building Administrator for further investigation and adjudication.
- 4. **Security.** Nespelem School District cannot and does not guarantee the security of electronic files located on Google systems. Although Google does have a powerful content filter in place for email, the District cannot assure that users will not be exposed to unsolicited information.
- 5. **Privacy.** The general right of privacy will be extended to the extent possible in the electronic environment. Nespelem School District and all electronic users should treat electronically stored information in individuals' files as confidential and private. However, users of student email are strictly prohibited from accessing files and information other than their own. The District reserves the right to access the username###@my.nsdeagles.org Google systems, including current and archival files of user accounts when there is reasonable suspicion that unacceptable use has occurred.
- 6. **Internet Safety:** We focus on internet safety and digital citizenship guidelines.
